PUBLIC WORKS:

- Chip Sealing should start by the end of this week depending on weather. Otherwise next Monday July 15, 2019. Roads that will be chipped sealed are Hillside Drive, Ginter Street, Valley Lane, Sewer plant lane and pOarking lot, N. Main, and N 3rd Street Total cost of \$34804.64.
- 2. Each year Grant County Municipalities have an option to petition the Grant County Highway Commission for up to \$2,000.00 in matching funds to help fund projects like mats, seals and culvert work. The petition needs to be submitted by August 31, 2019 to be in this year's funding. We currently have \$40,000.00 in account with Grant County. When we want to access this account we simply send in bills to the Commission for reimbursement.
 - a. **MOTION:** Ginter and Busch to send in the petition to the Grant County Highway for the \$2,000.00 matching funds. Approved.
- 3. Crack filling is done for the year. We are going to finish Rosalyn.
- 4. Wiederholt should be in by the end of this week to prep intersection of Domi and Orchard. Then gravel prep should be done in the next week or so and black top will be a few weeks after.
- 5. Estimate from Droessler Sand Blasting the big dump truck is \$1650.00. We need to have the truck sand blasted, clean and apply 2 coats of apoxy primer and 1 coat of apoxy finish inside of dump box to avoid any more rust. They will fix the rust spots that are inside of the box.
 - a. **MOTION:** T. George and Ginter to have the dump truck box done before winter. Approved.
- 6. Summer help has been doing very well and we need to find out when his last day will be. When he was hired, they stated that if everything was going well, they were going to give him a raise. MOTION: T. George and Ginter to approve raise for the summer help. Approved. Added to minutes was the summer help received a increase in wage from \$10.00 and hour to \$12.00 an hour.
