Halloween went well! Thank you, Dickeyville/Paris Fire Department, Dickeyville EMS and Dickeyville/Kieler Lion's Club for helping with traffic control and responding to the crash that occurred.

PUBLIC WORKS:

1. Future Sludge Sites – Luke and Dale met with Steven Dietzel on the possibility of hauling sludge on his property in Paris Township. We agreed to pay for soil analysis of 100 acres of land to be spread on. Robbie Lange has sent Dale his soil analysis for his farm on West Lane. Paperwork needs to be finalized on these two sites. Bytec finished hauling this year's sludge October 14, 2020.
2. Lab door at the Waste Water Treatment Plant – Dale spoke to Porter on the replacement and he is just waiting for the door to arrive.
3. Water Classes – Luke took 3 water classes on zoom. He has another one November 12, 2020 on fire hydrant maintenance. I am hoping DNR has certification exams for Luke to take soon.
4. Sanitary Survey – Every 3 years a Sanitary Survey is completed on the water system. Today, Dale finished the survey and submitted it.
5. Street Rating – The deadline is December 11, 2020 of this year. Dale has rated them and he just needs to finalize the paperwork.

A RESOLUTION RENAMING B's STREET TO PINE STREET EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 11, 2020

The Village Board of the Village of Dickeyville, Grant County, Wisconsin, does now ordain as follows:

Section I: The Village street currently named "B's Street" is to be renamed "Pine Street."

Section II: The street is described as the roadway entering the Loras Estates subdivision. The road starts at Park Street and runs north and south 158 feet. Bounded on the west by Lot 1 of Block 2 of B's Place Subdivision and bounded on the east by Lot 8 of Block B of H&B Subdivision.

Section III: This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption and publication of it or a summary of it as required by law.
