ORDINANCE NO. 2020-5

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 58 ENTITLED "OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES", SECTION 58-1 ENTITLED "ELECTED OFFICIALS", SUBSECTION 58-1.F. OF THE VILLAGE OF DICKEYVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Board of the Village of Dickeyville, Grant County, Wisconsin, does ordain as follows:

Section I: Chapter 58 entitled "Officers and Employees", Section 58-1 entitled "Elected Officials", Subsection 58-1.f. of the Village of Dickeyville Municipal Code shall be and hereby is amended.

58-1F. The salary of the Village President is hereby amended to \$400 per month with no additional stipend for special meetings; the salaries of the Trustees are hereby amended to \$910 per annuum; compensation for special meetings and the budget meeting and the meeting of the Board of Review is hereby amended to \$35 for Trustees.

These Amendments shall become effective with each new term for each Trustee and for the Village President.

Section II: This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication or posting as required by law. All other sections of Chapter 58 of the Village of Dickeyville Municipal Code not specifically amended under this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect as drafted.

- 6. Installed a new hydrant at intersection of S. Church St. and Rita Avenue. The old one leaked so we needed to replace it.
- 7. Dale has someone ask him about sidewalks in the Loras Estates.
- 8. Only plowed snow once and then only the middles because the snow was going to melt, there were vehicles parked on the wrong side of the streets. Will Donna have the ordinance about winter parking on the back of the Water & Sewer bills to remind the residents of the winter parking.
