### **ELECTIONS**

#### **§ 20-1. Wards.** <sup>1</sup>

The Village of Dickeyville is divided into two wards for the purposes of electing representatives to the Grant County Board and to facilitate election administration. The wards are as follows:

- A. First Ward: All of that area within the Village lying east and south of U.S. Highway 61 and North Main Street to the point where they intersect in the Village.
- B. Second Ward: All of that area within the Village lying west of North Main Street and north of U.S. Highway 61 from the point where they intersect in the Village.

#### **§ 20-2. Representation on County Board.**

Ward 1 shall be represented on the Grant County Board by Supervisor District No. 22 and Ward 2 shall be represented on the Grant County Board by Supervisor District No. 16.

#### **§ 20-3. Number of Election Officials.**

Pursuant to Section 7.32, Wisconsin Statutes, the number of election inspectors at each polling place may be three in total at polling places where voting machines are used. Further, there is hereby allowed the selection of alternate officials or the selection of two more sets of officials to work at different times on Election Day if the Village Clerk chooses to establish different working hours for officials assigned to the same polling place.
